Cooper Boulevard Roundabout

Construction has begun for a new roundabout at the intersection of Cooper Blvd and Memorial Dr.

This initiative responds to increased traffic on Cooper Boulevard, funded through the 2024 budget. A report by traffic engineers recommended the roundabout as the best solution to improve long-term safety at this busy intersection. The project is cost-shared through provincial Multi-Year Capital Works funding.

The Town understands that the introduction of a roundabout in the community may cause uncertainty. The Town of Gander is committed to providing ongoing information and educational resources to ensure a smooth transition.

Seniors' 'Rising Above the Rest' Fall Forum


Seniors' 'Rising Above the Rest' Fall Forum was held on September 27th.
